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Aye-ayes are the strangest of Madagascar's 80 lemur species.

They tap on trees with a special thin third finger.

If they hear a hollow sound they open the tree bark with their strong front teeth.

They use their special finger to scoop out insects, or nut meat, or the sweet nectar of flowers.

There are many legends about the aye-aye.

It is very difficult to see a wild aye-aye, because they are so shy.



Littoral Forest

Vitsy dia vitsy ireo alan'amorontsika tavela ao atsinanana'i Madagasikara.

700 ha sisa ny haben'ny alan'i Tampolo.

Ho fanitarana io ala dia volena ao ny karazan-kazo zanatany.

Fasi-potsy tsy mamokatra no anirian'ity karazan'ala ity, ka sarotra ny hameranana azy amin'ny laoniny raha ohatra ka kapaina izy.

Only a few small littoral forests remain on Madagascar's east coast.

Tampolo Reserve is only 700 hectares.

A nursery at Tampolo grows native hardwoods to extend the forest.

Littoral forest stands on infertile white sand, so if it is cut down the trees grow back extremely slowly.
