Reed-beds benefit people in many ways and provide a habitat for animals, fish, birds and insects.

Intact reed-beds support bandro and provide plenty of reeds for house-building, baskets and mats.

Reeds enable fish to breed and grow, and prevent soil, pollution and waste from entering the lake. They control the invasive snakehead fish and water hyacinth.

Reed-beds maintain a level of nutrient-rich ground-water to irrigate the rice-fields and protect them from flooding.

A healthy marshland is the legacy we should leave for future generations, ensuring continuity of the Sihanaka cultural heritage.
